Experts agree that concrete flooring should be sealed every 2-5 years to preserve and protect the floor rather than stripping and waxing.



Stripping and waxing requires extensive labor and is usually performed twice a year. There are also product and equipment costs to consider. Over a few years, the cost of waxing adds up.



The average cost to strip and wax floors can be as high as \$2.25 sq/ft. Expenses are affected by the type of finish, the condition of the floor, the time that it takes to complete and the amount of space that needs to be restored.
